## The Australian Sovereignty Party says **NO!**

... to the Carbon Tax. There is a more permanent solution towards air pollution issues. There are already 125 taxes in Australia; do we really need another one?

A carbon tax does not address the choking plumes of motor vehicle and industrial pollution that surrounds most developed cities of the world (which is the REAL problem for humanity and our environment). It will however increase the cost of living; that is a certainty! What we need is a real solution and common sense approach to reduce poisonous particulates in the air we breathe not another tax!

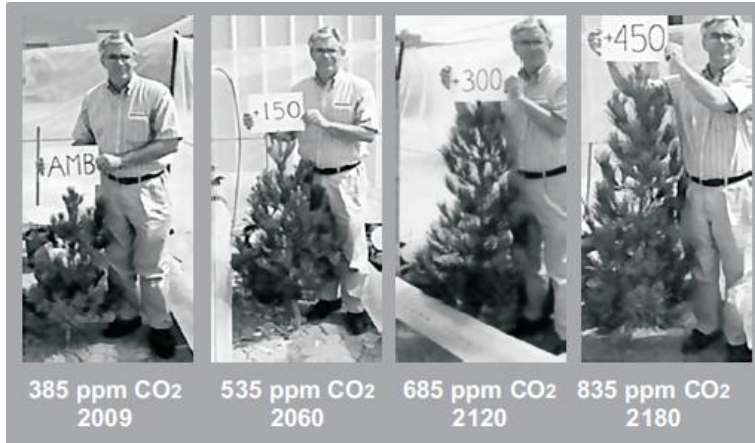
To create a better environment for all, we must address the main causes of pollution production which is mostly the result of our out-dated 20th century dependence on fossil fuels.

The reason we pay so many taxes in Australia is because our government irresponsibly borrows virtually every penny needed to sustain expenditure from private commercial banks that charge interest. That is right; the banks create the money, not the government. This is why there never seems to be enough money for hospitals, public services, police, road maintenance and infrastructures projects because the bulk of our taxes collected go straight to the banks to service this massive debt.

So a carbon tax in essence is just more money for the government to pay the banks with. It has nothing to do with improving the quality of the air we breathe and more to do with actually taxing the air we breathe.

## Why is the Australian Sovereignty Party against a Carbon Tax?

1. CO<sub>2</sub> is **NOT** a pollutant. It is a part of earth's natural carbon cycle to which the humans contribute only about 3.6%. Higher concentrations have proven benefits such as making plants grow faster and have no demonstrable effect on climate.

## What you don't know about the ETS:

- Average annual household electricity bills will rise by 25%, or \$280
- Australian food and grocery prices will rise by as much as 5%
- Regional Australia will lose 126,000 jobs
- Even if agriculture is not covered, the indirect cost for dairy farmers will be \$6000 - \$9000 per farm
- The farm cash income for an average beef farm will fall by over 60% if agriculture's emissions are included
- The economies of Gippsland, Geelong, central-west Queensland, central Western Australia, the Kimberley and Whyalla/Port Pirie will each shrink by more than 20%

## But regardless of the science, isn't alternative sustainable energy good for the environment?

Of course, but the ETS is potentially wasteful, diverting rivers of consumer money to a whole new industry of auditors, lawyers, traders, bankers and 'green' businessmen, waiting to trade in a new commodity you can hardly measure.

Spain has moved towards a renewable energy economy and has 19% unemployment and power costs have risen 100%.
